



Notice of Using Mcanism Cookies

As a Publisher you may be obliged—depending on the jurisdiction you are active in—to inform visitors of your website about cookies that are used on your website, including those placed by Mcanism (so-called third-party cookies). You should explain what cookies you and/or third-parties set and for what purposes you collect this information. Also, you need to obtain consent from users before setting any cookies in their browsers. The consent should also apply to the cookies installed by Mcanism.

Below is an example of a notice about using Mcanism cookies on your website. You can paste it in your cookie policy the way it is, alter it or draw up your own notice.

«We use a number of suppliers that may also set cookies on your device on our behalf when you visit our website to allow them to deliver the services they are providing. One of the suppliers is Mcanism. Mcanism is an affiliate network, that uses cookies to follow a user's click on a publisher's affiliate link through to purchase or lead on an advertiser's website and associate that back to the publisher who earns a commission off the purchase or the lead. The cookies are set at the moment a user clicks an affiliate link.
